

Coleman Exponent 2-Person Inyo Tent

This tent is lightweight, watertight, and designed for backpacking. It will keep you warm and dry during camping trips, and it is easy to set up and take down. This tent includes a tent body, rain fly, stakes, and tent poles.

Instructions for Setting Up

After finding a suitable space for setting up the tent, lay out and position the tent body with doors facing the desired directions. Stake down the tent corners, ensuring the floor is taut. Take the poles out of the pole bag and connect them. These poles are color-coded, so the yellow poles will go through the tent sleeves with yellow border, while the red poles will go through the tent sleeves with the red border. Insert pole tips into grommets, gradually applying pressure to form an arch to ensure the poles do not break. Drape the rainfly over the tent and connect the rainfly to the tent body if desired.
